Taiwan has been a top spender globally for semiconductor equipment and will be as strong in 2012 with estimated US\$8B or more in spending. For materials, this region is also a top spender and will spend about US\$10B in 2012. With the rising demand for advanced nodes, 3DIC, and copper wire transition, the investment momentum shall continue into 2012 from foundries and OSAT companies such as TSMC, UMC, ASE, SPIL, and Powertech. For LED segment, capacity expansion is expected to continue in 2012. Taiwan LED epi/chip makers are expected to invest more than \$700M to their facilities in Taiwan and China next year. For Southeast Asia region, fab spending will grow 43.8% year-on-year and is expected to reach US\$4B in equipment spending in 2012, which is 10% of the worldwide share and higher than Europe and Japan. Material wise, it is expected to exceed US\$7B, contributing 16% of the worldwide investment. South East Asia hosts top 3 foundries in the world, 6 of the world's top 10 fabless companies, 4 leading outsourced semiconductor assembly and test companies and numerous IDMs like Infineon, Intel, STMicroelectronics, and Texas Instruments.
